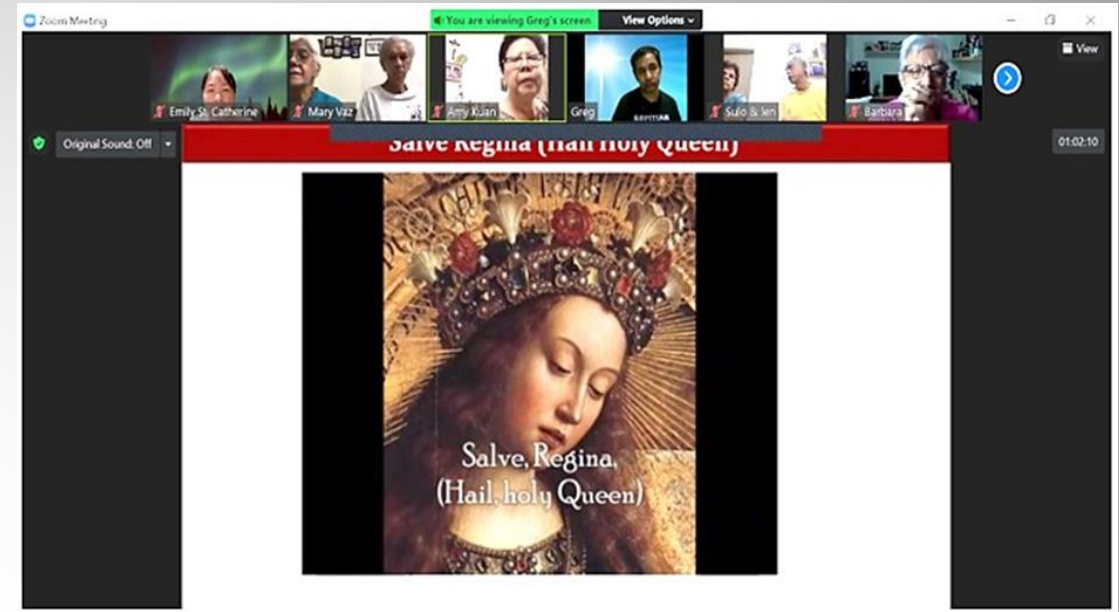

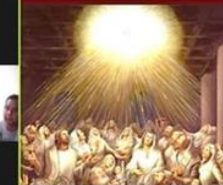

SALT OF THE EARTH AND LIGHT OF THE WORLD: COMMUNION, PARTICIPATION AND MISSION

FEAST OF *Corpus Christi* (19 JUNE)

INTRODUCTION:

At every Holy Mass, the Church fulfils the command of Christ, who on the evening before his death instituted the Holy Eucharist, saying, *"This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me"* (Luke 22:19), and then, *"This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you"* (Luke 22:20).

Following the command of Jesus, we continue to celebrate the Eucharist. We keep in mind the words of St Paul, that whenever we eat the bread, then, and drink the cup, we are proclaiming the Lord's death until he comes (1 Cor 11:26). We believe and have faith that Christ is truly and fully present in the bread and wine.



The feast of Corpus Christi is a time when we give praise and thanksgiving to Christ. By instituting the Holy Eucharist, Christ gave us our greatest spiritual nourishment for our journey as pilgrims here in this life.

The Body and Blood of Christ, which we all share, bring us to communion with one another and with Christ, who is in communion with the Father and the Spirit. This communion gave us, as Church, a new reality. This new reality means a life in which God is in communion with us now and where we hope to one day be in full communion with God. The feast of Corpus Christi reminds us of this reality in our identity as God's people.

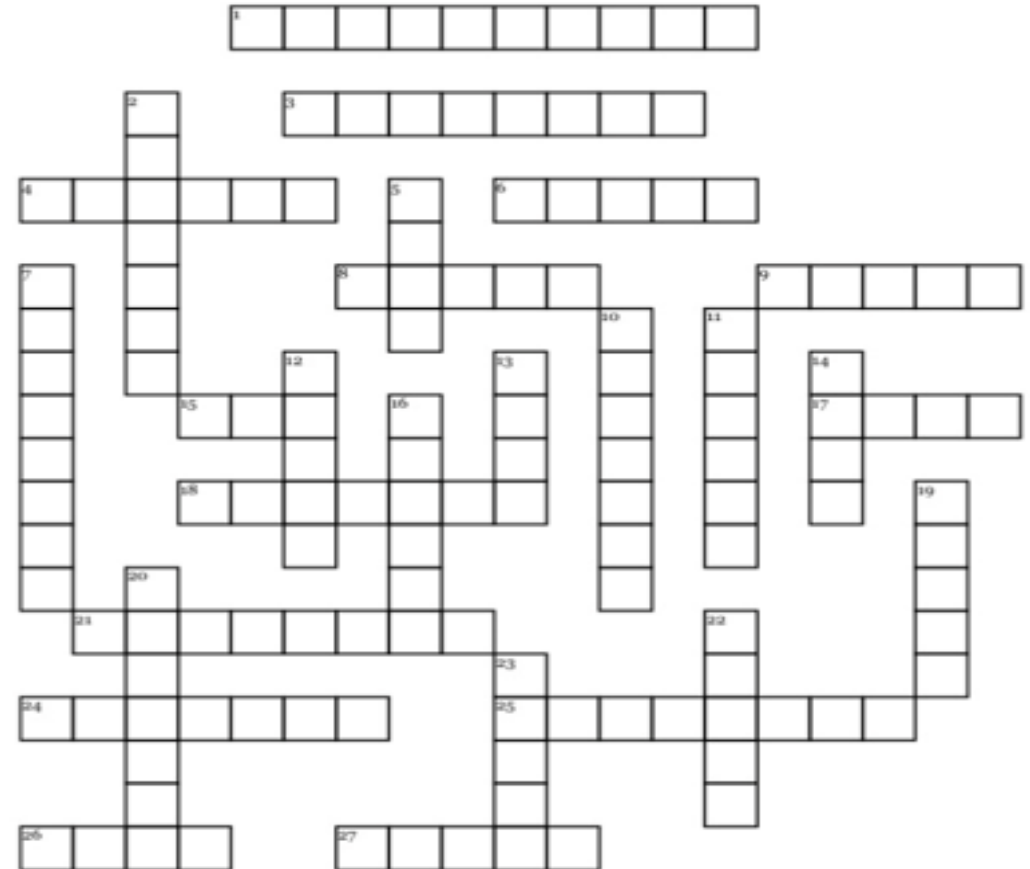
